

Your paragrIILM University, Greater Noida, conducted an H.R. Conclave with 40 to 50 Human Resource Personals from the industry on the theme "Moving towards the Next Gen HR: Unleashing the organisational Excellence" on 18th March 2023. The panel discussion took place and was moderated by Prof. Rajkishan S.S Nair. They were several speakers on that panel, Ms. Dipti Vij (CHRO- Honeywell), Mr. Abhay Kapoor (Head HR and Admn.- Suzuki Motor Gujarat), Mr. Manoj Kumar Kamra (Director-Talent Acquisition- CVent), Mr Subrat Kumar (CEO- People Labs), least Mr. Harsh Raj Jain (Head of Talent APAC- Human Capital Management-Ebix Inc) and Mr. Sungkritayayan Khan (VP Human Resource- Extramarks). They discussed technology integration with standard curriculum can give the workforce a sense of power and allow for more advanced learning among broad topics.

"Fish are surrounded by water. It is hard to see the external environment from there, but they need to jump up to do that", Ms. Shyamali Sathpathy, through her words, suggested that constant change in the H.R. is a dire need of the present time.

Ms Dipti Vij (CHRO- Honeywell) inspired by the saying "organisational excellence is not about the management of quality. It is about the quality of management". She further stated that communication is the key to accomplishing an organisation's goals. Mr. Abhay Kapoor (Head HR & Admin, Suzuki Motor Gujrat), talked about today's business scenario and how it will contribute to developing any business model. He explained the poor generation of the workforce existing in the marketplace and tried to remind the students that we need to keep in mind the new generation's requirements by being as agile as possible.

"Change begins at the end of your comfort zone", Mr Sungkritayayan Khan (V.P Human Resource- Extramarks), made everybody realise the importance of adapting to change. Giving an example of remembering the storyline of a movie one has watched and forgetting the concept one has learned. He explained that one must study the subject or concept he or she is interested in. Dr Manoj Kumar Kamra (Director- Talent Acquisition- CVent), stressed change management and learning ability. Change management skills are skills that you can use to help your company through the process of making organisational changes. Good change management can be critical to the success of a company. He focused on data analytics and how it can be proved to be very powerful in the marketplace. He concluded by saying that "People don't resist change. They resist being changed."

Mr. Subrat Kumar (CEO-People Labs), enriched the people with about four stakeholders for the Next Gen H.R., i.e. Organization, H.R., Students and Faculties. Like the other speakers, he also stressed the necessity of adapting to change as it is a crucial factor in every sector. Last, Mr Harsh Raj Jain (Head of Talent APAC-Human Capital Management-Ebix Inc) advised the audience to start everything passionately and have a firm base like a triangle. We should move away from destruction as they are increasing these days. He concluded by stating that networking, curiosity and vigilance are very important.

After the panel discussion, students put forward their queries through a Q&A round. Lastly, Dr Taruna Gautam, VC, IILM University, felicitated the guests. It was a very insightful session for both the students and the faculties present there as they learned a lot from experienced HRs of various industry companies. There is always a team behind the success of an event. We are indebted to our placement cell for helping and support us in the event.

IILM University, Greater Noida organised an excursion for the students of Journalism, Law and Psychology to Sahitya Akademi, Ferozeshah Road, New Delhi, for attending Sahityautsav-Festival of Letters 2023 on 14th March, 2023 under the guidance of professor Aditi Gupta, Dipti Pandey, Rachit Sharma and Paras Yadav. Festival of Letters is an annual festival of Sahitya Akademi, it includes exhibitions, national seminars, tribal writers' meet, award presentations, programmes for children, etc. The first Festival of Letters was organised in 1985 with few writers and programmes. This year is the 39th edition of the Festival.

This year the focus was on the G20 theme- One Earth, One Family, One Future, besides panel discussion on Education and Creativity, Diplomacy and Literature and Women Empowerment. Sahitya Akademi conducted Media Interaction with Sahitya Akademi Award 2022 winning writers at Valmiki Sabhagar. Humra Qureshi and Amarnath 'Amar' moderated the programme. At the programme, the award-winning writers interacted with the literary connoisseurs and representatives of the Media. It was a six day programme i.e. from 11th- 16th March, 2023.

The students attended the LGBTQ Writers' Meet at Vyas Sabhagar at 2:30 p.m. The first speaker for that session was Ms Devika, member of the U.P Transgender Welfare Board. She raised the question as to why we still need a special LGBTQ programme to give rights and recognition to those people when the law regarding the same is already in place. She stressed its inclusiveness in society. She enlightened everybody on the fact that India was the 3rd country to recognise Transgender as legal gender in 2014.

Mrs C. K. Dariyali, chairman of the Women's Development Corporation, reflected on how Britishers applied the anti-buggery act of 1533 to India to criminalise non-procreative sexuality, which targeted transgenders, homosexuals and people of different sexual orientations. She showed pictures of few people of the LGBTQIA+ community who have done and who are doing great in various fields such as Nartaki Nataray, Noori Amma, J.S Radhakrishnan, etc. She stated that there are many states which still do not have a Transgenders Board yet and that there is only one bank till now which lends money to LGBTQIA+ community for micro enterprises in India. She focused on the idea that there is a need to create awareness among the families, society educational institutions and employers to accept their children, students and employees irrespective of their sexual identities.

The students learned a lot and got inspired by all the outstanding writers by listening to their work and writing. It was great fun for them to encounter such an event with many award winners and eminent personalities. The students also visited the art gallery there and saw some amazing art pieces. Overall, it was an experience of good social exposure, gaining knowledge and fun.

School of Engineering & Technology

A session on "Next-generation TV broadcasting in the 5G era" on 20TH MARCH, 2023.

The IILM University in Greater Noida, in collaboration with the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers, has organised a session on "Next-generation TV broadcasting in the 5G era" on 20th March, 2023. The event was conducted by the Department of Mechanical and Allied Engineering. The session was taken by two prominent speakers: Mr. Raman Kumar, Director (International Relations), Prasar Bharati, Delhi, and Col. (Dr.) Bipin Pandey, Chairperson of IETE, Noida. The session aimed to explore the potential of 5G technology in transforming the TV broadcasting landscape and enabling high-quality, immersive viewing experiences for audiences.





Mr. Kumar talked about what India's public broadcasting company, Prasar Bharati, is doing to use 5G technology to improve TV broadcasting. He highlighted the benefits of using 5G for live streaming of events, on-demand content delivery, and personalised viewing experiences. He also discussed the challenges of implementing 5G-based TV broadcasting, such as spectrum allocation and infrastructure development, and the need for collaboration between stakeholders. Col.(Dr.) Bipin Pandey sensitised students related to the benefits of the IETE student forum.



- Prof. M. Afzal Wani, Dean School of Law, IILM University, presented a paper titled 'IPR and Constitutional Commitments for development (State Responsibilities) at the 5th IP and Innovation Researchers of Asia (IPIRA) Conference. – 01/03/2023 to 03/03/2023
 - "Intellectual Property Rights are definitely emerging as next to nothing, that has become a vehicle for the development of humanity, and these are giving true hope and shape to constitutional commitments about human development. As understood before and after the World Wars, the understanding of rights was more a kind of privileges, conferred on people after a long history of oppression under feudalism, kingship, anarchy, lawless communities, customs, tribal policies, religion, casteism, regionalism and gender discrimination. By initiating the constitutionalism, the situation and the understanding underwent a slow change in thinking and action, but largely in most parts of the world the true implementation of constitutional agenda for development for all remains a sweet day dream. Now, the emergence of new technologies, trends in more application of mind and culture of invention and innovation has changed the old inertia and transformed it into action, engaging all human beings in the new IPR dynamics leading to opening of previous shackles of bondage and involvements with the unscientific fictions. The developed world has now come out to share their fruits of scientific investigation and technologies with the other parts of the world. The bond is growing so strong that the national borders had to melt to give space to more international movements, understanding of global cooperation and regulation of human actions by prime constitutional commitments to liberty, equality, justice and relevance of institutions of United Nations.
 - oln India, a big leap is found from the ground, in the form of scientific studies, inventions and discoveries leading to perpetual efforts of innovation. The copy right, patent, trade mark, designs and geographical indications are being taken with seriousness to equip self with entitlements, invigorating the feelings of energy to work more, to create more and have more power. This incentivisation by the IPR movement proved extremely educative, influencing people to do more for self-help, self-respect, self-reliance which could not happen before the IPR Regime started showing its results. The impact is visible from various legislations and litigations, reflective of citizens capacity to stive more. The IPRs came up as complimentary to constitutional values and culture. This idea needs more elaboration and popularity to understand the significance of IPRs with constitutional developments, especially in the developing economies like India and other Asian economies and legal systems.


