Instructions to Students During Examinations

- 1. Students are strictly instructed not to carry bags or any restricted materials inside the Block.
- 2. Bags and personal belongings may be kept outside the Block; however, the University and the Office of the Controller of Examinations will **not be responsible for any loss, misplacement, or damage.**
- 3. Students must report to the examination hall **15 minutes** before the scheduled start of the examination.
- 4. No student will be permitted to enter the hall **30 minutes** after the commencement of the examination.
- 5. Students must carry their Admit Card/Hall Ticket and a valid University ID card for verification.
- 6. Students without a valid University ID card will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- 7. The **student seating plan** will be available on the **University website -> Examination** link 24 hours before the scheduled examination.
- 8. Students must occupy their allotted seat as per the seating plan and should not change seats without permission from the invigilator.
- 9. Verify that you have received the correct question paper and answer booklet.
- 10. Fill in all required details (URN/Roll No., Subject Code, etc.) before starting your answers.
- 11. Only approved stationery (pens, pencils, erasers, rulers) is allowed inside the hall.
- 12. For **open book examinations**, only valid documents/books/materials prescribed by the Department are allowed, and these must be cross-verified and signed by the concerned Incharge.
- 13. Mobile phones, Ear pads, smart devices, electronic gadgets, written/printed notes, or any unauthorized materials are strictly prohibited. Possession of such items will be treated as Unfair Means (UFM).
- 14. Maintain complete silence and do not communicate with other students during the examination.
- 15. Raise your hand if you need assistance. Do not leave your seat without invigilator permission.
- 16. Students are not allowed to leave the examination hall during the **first 30 minutes and the last**15 minutes of the examination.
- 17. Write neatly and legibly using blue or black ink pen only.
- 18. Do not write your name or make any identifying marks on the answer booklet.
- 19. Rough work must be done only in the space provided in the answer booklet.
- 20. Stop writing immediately when the invigilator announces the end of the examination.
- 21. Hand over the answer booklet to the invigilator before leaving the hall.
- 22. Students who leave without submitting their answer booklet will be treated as absent.
- 23. Any malpractice (copying, using mobile/Al tools, discussion with others, etc.) will result in cancellation of the examination and strict disciplinary action.
- 24. Follow all instructions of the invigilators and maintain discipline inside and outside the examination hall at all times.
