Introduction:

IILM University, Greater Noida, is committed to fostering academic excellence and providing a diverse and inclusive learning environment. Our admission policy is designed to ensure a transparent, merit-based selection process that aligns with the university's mission and the guidelines set forth by regulatory bodies.

Programs Offered

Eligibility Criteria:

Eligibility criteria vary across the program and are in accordance with the standards prescribed by relevant regulatory authorities. Prospective students are advised to consult the specific program details on the

university's website or official announcements by contacting the Admissions Office for comprehensive information.

The eligible students who apply for Management, Law, Liberal Arts and Social Sciences in IILM University, Greater Noida have to undergo an online/in-person interview conducted at 22 locations across the country. For applicants to the Engineering and Computer Science programs, participation in the Engineering Entrance Examination (EEE) is mandatory, which is conducted online. Based on their performance in the EEE, the shortlisted candidates are invited for a personal interview. Admission is considered for the students who fulfil the minimum cutoff score as per established admission criteria.

The final admission and decision thereon rest with the Admission Committee, whose decision or orders are considered binding. The Admission Committee also oversees and approves the admission policy, introducing changes or modification if any, looking into the response and situations which warrant such change or modification(s).

Students can apply anytime and for those who meet the eligibility criteria are informed to apply for the admission process, for the academic session/year.

1. Undergraduate (UG) Programs

- Qualification: 10+2 (or equivalent) from a recognized board.
- Minimum Marks Required: 50% aggregate in the qualifying examination.
- · Additional Requirements (as applicable):
 - o B.Tech: Must have studied Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics as core subjects.
 - BA LL.B: CLAT/LSAT/AILET scores preferred.
 - o Entrance Examination (as applicable) may be considered for specific programs.
 - For all Engineering and Computer Science programs, students need to appear for IILM EEE examination. However the same is not applicable for candidates who scored 60 percentile and above in JEE.

2. Postgraduate (PG) Programs

- Qualification: Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline from a recognized university.
- Minimum Marks Required: 50% aggregate in the qualifying examination.
- Additional Requirements (as applicable):
 - o M.Tech: GATE score preferred.
 - MBA: CAT/XAT/MAT/CMAT/GMAT scores preferred.
 - LL.M: Must have completed LL.B or equivalent.

3. Doctoral Program:

For eligibility of admission in the Ph.D. programs, the university follows the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC):

- Candidates must have a Master's degree or equivalent in a relevant discipline from a recognized university.
- A minimum of 55% aggregate marks (or equivalent grade).
- Candidates with NET (UGC) / JRF / GATE / SLET or equivalent qualification will be preferred.

• Admission to the Ph.D. program will be based on the IILM University Ph.D. Entrance Test followed by a personal interview.

Admission Process:

Stage 1: Admission Notice:

The Admission Announcement for admission to various programs of study is published in National Dailies, Website, and through AIMA Brochure, circulation of posters and banners at prominent locations and various Social Media platforms. Students appearing in CAT/XAT/NMAT/SNAP/MAT/GMAT/CUET apply for the MBA programme, based on their valid scores. Detailed information on the admission process and tests conducted can be obtained from the advertisements released in various national dailies or from the respective Schools/Departments of the university. The University also accepts admission through CUET.

Stage 2: Eligibility Criteria & Online Form Submission-

- Every candidate seeking admission to UG and PG programs at IILM University must fill out the online application form, attach the requisite documents, and submit the same at the time of the Personal Interview.
- Shortlisted candidates will be informed via **email and official communication** regarding the interview schedule.
- For outstation candidates, the **Personal Interviews** will be conducted at **major cities**, and updates regarding the **Interview Centre** will be available on the university website...

Stage 3: Selection Procedure

A. Personal Interview Process (20% Weightage). For non-MBA programmes (40%)

- Shortlisted candidates are invited for the Personal Interview based on their application review.
- Candidates must ensure that their **online application form** is complete; otherwise, a **hard copy** is to be provided, whose entries/details will be considered final.
- · Candidates are required to submit:
 - All previous academic mark sheets (10th, 12th, Graduation, etc.)
 - Passport-sized photograph
 - Case Study (if applicable)
- The interview panel shall consist of two members, and the interview duration is approximately 30-45 minutes.

B. Group Discussion (Applicable for MBA - 20% Weightage)

- A Group Discussion (GD) round is conducted exclusively for MBA applicants.
- Candidates are assigned to panels for evaluation, each consisting of atleast two faculty members.
- After receiving all applications, candidates are shortlisted for GD/PI by the Admission Committee.
- The shortlisted candidates then undergo Panel Interviews.
- . Minimum cut-off marks for final admission is 65%.
- A final review of credentials is conducted by the panel, and if discrepancies are found, a reference check is carried out.

C. Academic Performance Weightage (20%)

• 10th, 12th, and Graduation scores contribute to the selection criteria.

D. Competitive Exam Scores (40%)

Candidates appearing for exams such as CAT/MAT/XAT/NMAT/SNAP/GMAT/CUET receive 40% weightage in the admission process.

Weightage Breakdown for Admission Process:

Stage 4: Selection & Result Declaration

- After the completion of the selection process, the final result is declared based on the cut-off.
- The result sheet is prepared according to the specified admission criteria and uploaded on the university website.
- · Admission results are categorized into:
 - Selected
 - Rejected
 - Waitlisted
 - Provisional Admission
 - Scholarship Awardees

Stage 5: Offer Letter & Fee Payment

Once the final selection is approved:

- Offer Letters are issued to the selected candidates.
- The offer letter includes details regarding the last date for fee payment.
- Offer letters will be sent by the Office. The SoP for Document verification will be followed by the Admission Office. The university may engage competitive agencies or adopt ICT/ERP packages, ensuring secure digital communication.
- Candidates can pay the admission fee through various online payment modes or integrated platforms as communicated in the offer letter.
- For students opting for EMI schemes/Education Loans, relevant documents will be required. Necessary hand holding through nationalized banks will be facilitated.

Admission Kit for Registered Students:

Selected candidates receive an Admission Kit, which includes:

- 1. About the Campus & University Legacy
- 2. AICTE / UGC Approvals
- 3. Fee Details

- 4. Scholarship Information
- 5. Residential Program Details
- 6. Admission Process Overview

Stage 6: Registration & Final Admission

- Admission is finalized only after the candidate pays the requisite fee and security deposit, as mentioned in the Admission Offer Letter.
- The Registration Process is conducted as per the schedule determined by the Admission Committee and approved by the Academic Council of IILM University.

Scholarship criteria:

- Merit-based scholarships are offered to eligible candidates.
- Important Guidelines:
 - No two scholarships can be combined.
 - o Scholarship amount is offered as a percentage of tuition fees.
 - Scholarships are available in limited numbers.
 - o Final decision regarding scholarships is subject to the approval of the Admission Committee.

IILM University, Greater Noida, follows a transparent, merit-based admission process to ensure that deserving candidates are selected based on academic performance, entrance examination scores, and personal interviews.
